

Initiative for Policy Dialogue at Columbia University's Task Force on International Migration Second meeting January 15-16, 2009, UNAM, Mexico City

The central point of the task force is to assess the developmental effects of migration. During the past meeting, the task force devoted a significant amount of time discussing how to maximize development and well-being in developing countries.

The sessions will be structured as follows: we will have a 20 minute presentation on a particular research question followed by a 10 minute comment by a commentator, which will then lead a 30 minute discussion from all the participants.

The moderator/commentator will be in charge of guiding the discussion and to take note of the task force member's views on that particular topic so it can be incorporated into the edited volume. The last session of the meeting will concentrate on summarizing the main contributions of the sessions as well as on the following steps for the second meeting, which will focus on migration from a regional perspective.
