Committee in the House, his advisors, and IPD group.

Main topics: There is no government project presented to the House until now. The main government topics are related to civil servants and militaries personnel.

- PL 9, that creates a maximum value of pension to be paid in the public sector and creates additional Pension Fund (previdência pública complementar) for wages over this maximum value;
- New access rules for civil servants;
- The pensions will consider the last wage netted of pension contributions (11%);
- Pensions for wives or children will have a discount of 30%
